INDIA CENTRIC

JANUARY

- At Jantar Mantar, a number of Indian wrestlers, including Sakshi Malik, Vinesh Phogat, and Bajrang Punia, demonstrate against Brij Bhushan Sharan Singh, the chief of the Wrestling Federation of India, over allegations of sexual harassment.
- A portion of the Uttarakhand town of Joshimath sinks, illustrating the dangers of excessive growth in steep regions.
- On January 1, 2023, the horrifying Pakistan-backed Rajouri assaults occurred in the Indian union territory of Jammu and Kashmir's Rajouri district.

FEBRUARY

- Manish Sisodia and Satyendra Jain resign from their ministerial positions following their arrests by CBI in the liquor policy case.
- On February 14, the Income Tax Department surveyed British Broadcasting Corporation offices in Delhi and Mumbai to check for legal noncompliance.

MARCH

- The Foreign Trade Policy (2015-20) concluded on March 31, 2022, following extensions prompted by the COVID-19 pandemic. Commerce Minister Piyush Goyal unveiled the transformative Foreign Trade Policy 2023-28 on March 31, 2023, with the aim of reinvigorating exports in a challenging global trade landscape.
- Stepwell fall in Indore, Madhya Pradesh: At a Hindu temple in Indore, thirty-six persons are killed and seventeen injured as a stepwell collapses during prayers.
- The Central Government exempted all drugs and special medical food from basic customs duty for the treatment of Rare Diseases, including pembrolizumab for cancer. This move, in line with the National Policy for Rare Diseases 2021, aims to provide cost relief and improve access to essential treatments for individuals facing these conditions.

APRIL

- Based on UN figures, India surpassed China to become the world's most populated country. India now has a population of over 1.428 billion, little more than China's 1.425 billion.
- A new income tax legislation is implemented. It represents a substantial improvement over the previous 1961 act and includes a contentious "angel tax" clause intended to seize a portion of the money coming into the nation from overseas investors supporting start-ups in India.
- Gangsters Ashraf Ahmed and Atique Ahmed were slain in a shooting in Prayagraj, along with their brother.

MAY

- Launching the new Parliament building, Prime Minister Narendra Modi places the sacred 'Sengol' in the Lok Sabha chamber.
- Ethnic violence erupted in India's north-eastern state of Manipur between the Meitei people, a majority that lives in the Imphal Valley, and the Kuki-Zo tribal community from the surrounding hills. Almost 175 people have been killed in the violence.
- By September 2023, the Reserve Bank of India plans to remove all 2000 rupee notes from circulation.

JUNE

- In the Balasore area of Odisha, train number 12841 Coromandel Express, traveling at 130 km/h (81 mph), collides with a freight train (goods train). The train was traveling from Shalimar railway station, which is close to Kolkata, to Chennai Central when the accident occurred at approximately 19:30 IST near Bahanaga Bazar station. Over two dozen coaches were overturned. There have been reports of around 280 fatalities and over 900 injuries.
- In the states of Uttar Pradesh and Bihar, a heat wave that claimed at least 96 lives.



JULY

- Riots break out across Nuh district in Haryana.
- At least 41 persons are killed in Punjab and Himachal Pradesh by flash floods and heavy rain.
- At the Namami Gange project site in Uttarakhand, a power transformer explodes, leaving 15 people dead and 7 injured.
- Outrage spreads around the nation after a video of two women in Manipur being paraded nude and the target of egregious acts of sexual abuse by a gang of tribal men goes viral.

AUGUST

- In the midst of an opposition walkout over the current violence in Manipur, the Rajya Sabha passes the Forest Conservation Act Amendment Bill, allowing the diversion of forest land for security and strategic purposes.
- The Rajya Sabha passes the contentious Delhi Ordinance Bill, granting the federal government authority over the nomination and removal of National Capital officials.
- India has become the first country to successfully land a spacecraft on the moon's south pole and only the fourth country ever to land on the moon on 23 August.

SEPTEMBER

- Clashes between Maratha reservation activists and Maharashtra Police in Jalna, Maharashtra, after Manoj Jarange Patil's indefinite hunger strike.
- Aditya-L1, India's first solar observation mission, is launched to research solar winds and solar flares, their effects on Earth and near-space weather, and to examine the solar corona, photosphere, and chromosphere.
- At the G20 meeting in New Delhi, an agreement was reached and the Delhi Declaration was created. The African Union was granted permanent membership in the G20 during the summit.
- During a Parliament session, the Women's Reservation Bill, 2023 was introduced in the Lok Sabha. The goal of this legislation is to give women 33 percent of the seats in the state legislative assemblies and the directly elected Lok Sabha.

OCTOBER

- In Sikkim, 22,000 people are affected by glacial lake outburst causing severe flooding. This is the largest calamity of its kind to hit the area in more than 50 years.
- The Supreme Court unanimously declined to recognise same-sex marriages, and adoption rights but said that transgender persons in heterosexual relationships have the right to marry under existing law.

NOVEMBER

- After being stuck in a collapsed road tunnel for more than two weeks, 41 construction workers are freed.
- The AQI of Delhi was recorded more than the mark of 450 nearly 10 times the acceptable limit.

DECEMBER

- The Lok Sabha witnessed shocking scenes on December 13 when two persons jumped into the House from the public gallery, carrying gas canisters.
- Parliament passes three new criminal code laws that completely overhaul India's policing system.
- India saw a single day rise of 702 cases of COVID-19, with the number of active cases of the infection rising to 4,097, the health ministry said on Thursday, December 28, 2023.
- Qatar commutes death sentence of former Indian Navy personnel imprisoned in Qatar.
- A five-judge Constitution bench of the Supreme Court unanimously upheld the validity of the Union government's 2019 decision to abrogate Article 370 of the Constitution on December 11.
- Pro-Kannada groups run riot in Bengaluru over order to use '60% Kannada' signages.

GLOBAL EVENTS

JANUARY

- China reopens its borders to international visitors, marking the end of travel restrictions that began in March 2020.
- Yeti Airlines Flight 691 crashes during the final approach into Pokhara, Nepal, killing all 72 people on board.
- Novak Djokovic wins his 22nd Grand Slam at the Australian Open to equal Rafael Nadal's record.

FEBRUARY

- US tracked alleged Chinese spy balloons over the Americas, with one drifting from Yukon to South Carolina before being shot down, and a second hovering over Colombia and Brazil.
- Cyclone Freddy forms in the Indian Ocean. It would become the longest lasting tropical cyclone in history and cause over 1,400 deaths and countless injuries and property damage across southeastern Africa.
- A 7.8 magnitude earthquake hits southern and central Turkey and northern and western Syria followed by a 7.7 magnitude aftershock on the same day, causing widespread damage and more than 59,000 fatalities and 121,000 injured.
- Russia suspends its participation in New Start, a nuclear arms reduction treaty with the US.

MARCH

- China's National People's Congress unanimously re-elects Xi Jinping as president of the People's Republic of China to an unprecedented third term.
- Silicon Valley Bank, the 16th largest bank in the US, fails, creating then the largest bank failure since the 2008 financial crisis.

APRIL

- Finland becomes the 31st member of NATO, doubling the alliance's border with Russia.
- Nuclear power in Germany ends after 50 years, with the closure of the final powerplants.
- SpaceX's Starship rocket, the largest and most powerful rocket ever built, launches for the first time in a test flight from Texas. It explodes four minutes after launch.

MAY

- San Francisco-based First Republic Bank collapsed on 1st of May, becoming the second largest collapse in US history after SVB.
- The WHO ends its declaration of Covid-19 being a global health emergency.
- The coronation of Charles III and Camilla as King and Queen of the United Kingdom is held in Westminster Alb London.
- Cyclone Mocha forms in the Indian Ocean, killing over 400 people and injuring over 700 as it strikes Myanmar and Bangladesh.

JUNE

- Scientists report the creation of the first synthetic human embryo from stem cells, without the need for sperm or egg cells.
- All five crew members of Titan, a deep-sea submersible exploring the wreck of the Titanic, are killed following a catastrophic implosion of the vessel.
- The Wagner Group, led by Yevgeny Prigozhin, begins an armed conflict with the Russian military. The rebellion came to an end soon, and Prigozhin died in plane crash a couple of months later.

JULY

- President Mohamed Bazoum of Niger is toppled in a coup d'état.
- Twitter CEO Elon Musk changes the app's official name to 'X'.
- Indian oil refiners start payments for Russian oil imports in Chinese yuan as an alternative to the US dollar due to increasing sanctions against Russia.

AUGUST

- Wagner Group leader Yevgeny Prigozhin killed in plane crash.
- Donald Trump was arrested and released in the Georgia election fraud case.
- Narendra Modi's government wins a no-trust motion, tabled by the I.N.D.I.A alliance.
- Former Pakistan PM Imran Khan is arrested in a corruption case and disqualified from politics for 5 years.
- 17,000 acres of land are burned and at least 100 people are killed when a series of wildfires break out on the island of Maui in Hawaii.

SEPTEMBER

- A 6.9 magnitude earthquake strikes western Morocco, killing at least 2,960 people and damaging historic buildings.
- Asian Games started on September 23 where India won over 100 medals including 28 gold and 38 silver. This was the first time that India won over 100 medals.
- Canadian PM Justin Trudeau accuses India of having a hand in the murder of pro-Khalistani terrorist Hardeep Singh Nijjar.
- Storm Daniel made landfall in Libya, bringing severe weather conditions, including strong winds and sudden heavy rainfall that affected several areas in the country. The massive flooding killed more than 4,300 people, while more than 8,500 are still missing.

OCTOBER

- Hamas launches an incursion into southern Israel from the Gaza Strip, prompting a military response from the Israel Defense Forces.
- After seven years, NASA's first asteroid (Bennu Asteroid) sample returned to Earth on October 4, which shows evidence of high carbon content & water.

NOVEMBER

- World's first AI Safety Summit takes place in UK; 28 countries signing a "world first agreement" on how to manage the riskiest forms of artificial intelligence.
- India loses the World Cup to Australia. After 10 consecutive wins, India lost the World Cup trophy by just a few inches.
- Chinese president Xi Jinping visits the United States for the first time since 2017 to hold a key summit with US President Joe Biden.
- In Nigeria, bandits kill 160 people in Plateau State.
- After weeks of earthquakes, a volcanic eruption occurs near Grindavík, Iceland.

DECEMBER

- At the COP28 climate summit in Dubai, a consensus is reached for countries to "transition away" from fossil fuels, the first such agreement in the conference's 30-year history.
- At least 23 troops were killed and 32 others injured in a gun and suicide bomb attack in a police station in Dera Ismail Khan, northwest Pakistan. A new Pakistani Islamist militant group called Tehreek-e-Jihad Pakistan (TJP) claimed responsibility.
- At least 127 people have been killed in north-west China in the country's deadliest earthquake for years.
- Militants attack a military camp and village in central Mali, killing close to two dozen soldiers and at least five civilians.
