### Overview

Mumbai and Pune will see major traffic restrictions and crowd-related disruptions on April 13-14 for the 134th birth anniversary of Dr. B.R. Ambedkar. Authorities expect large gatherings and have issued advisories urging residents to avoid high-traffic zones, plan alternate routes, and use public transport. Emergency access will be maintained, while parking will be strictly regulated.

# Major Traffic Restrictions and Parking Guidelines

### Mumbai

Regulation Timing: April 13, 12 PM to April 14, 12 AM Road Closures/One-Way Changes:

- · S.K. Bole Road: One-way from Siddhivinayak to Portuguese Church
- · S.V.S. Road: Closed Siddhivinayak to Yes Bank Jn. (Use Pandurang
- · Ranade Road & Dnyaneshwar Mandir Road: Fully closed
- · Heavy Vehicles: Diverted from Mahim Jn. via L.J. Road (BEST buses allowed)

## Alternate Routes:

- Southbound:
- Kalanagar Jn. → Dharavi T-Jn. → Sion/Dr. B.A. Road OR Bandra-Worli Sea Link
- · Northbound:
- From Colaba/CSMT: P D'mello → Nath Pai → Zakaria Bunder → RAK Rd → Sion
- From Mahalaxmi: Dr. E. Moses → Rakhangi Chowk → Senapati Bapat Rd
- From EEH: Wadala Bridge ightarrow Barkat Ali Naka ightarrow BPT Colony ightarrowEastern Freeway

# No Parking Zones:

· S.V.S. Road, Ranade Road, Dnyaneshwar Mandir Road, Keluskar Road (S & N)

### **Designated Parking Areas:**

· Senapati Bapat Rd (Mahim/Dadar), Kohinoor Square, India Bulls Finance & Center, Kamgar Stadium, Five Gardens (RAK 4th Rd)

Movement Restrictions: April 13: 7 PM to 2 AM, April 14: From 6 AM until dispersal of crowds

# Closed/High-Traffic Areas:

- Maldhakka Chowk, Pune Station, RTO Chowk avoid due to full/partial closures and slow movement
- Nehru Chowk, Tin Tofa Chowk, MG Road subject to sudden closures depending on crowd size

### No Parking Zones:

- Strictly enforced; vehicles without emergency clearance may be towed
- Emergency Access:
- Sassoon Hospital accessible via mortuary gate only; general entry restricted
- Designated Parking for Visitors:
- · SSPMS Ground, near RTO
- · Tukaram Shinde lot
- · Sassoon Colony (near Dr. Ambedkar statue)

### Key issues

- · Severe traffic congestion due to road closures, diversions, and high footfall in key city areas.
- · Restricted access to central business districts, hospitals (except emergencies), and public offices.
- Public transport overcrowding as many shift to trains and buses amid parking bans.
- Last-minute road closures depending on crowd size may cause confusion and delays.
- Noise and disruptions in residential areas along the procession
- Limited parking availability, with towing likely in no-parking zones.

### **General Advisory**

- · Avoid non-essential travel through central areas and procession routes on April 13-14.
- Use public transport where possible; parking restrictions will be strictly enforced.
- · You can expect significant delays and diversions; plan routes ahead and allow extra travel time.
- · Stay updated via official traffic police social media handles for realtime changes.
- Emergency services access will remain operational—do not block emergency routes.
- Please don't leave vehicles unattended in key zones to prevent towing or fines.
- Residents near procession hotspots should stock up on essentials in advance.
