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INDIA UPDATE

Highlights of this week

Andhra Pradesh

- CM N. Chandrababu Naidu launched the JSW Industrial Park in Vizianagaram district, with the first phase expected to attract ₹531 crore in investment and generate around 45,000 direct and indirect jobs, boosting industrial growth in North Andhra.
- MA&UD minister P Narayana has directed officials to immediately invite tenders for approved Amaravati projects, resolve farmers' land pooling issues and expedite housing works, while introducing new road safety measures for capital construction.

Delhi

- The Delhi Government has withdrawn its two-day work-from-home policy for most departments as the geopolitical situation normalised, while revising office timings to 10 am–6:30 pm from the earlier 10:30 am–7 pm schedule.
- The Government has transferred 52 finance officers and promoted 19 others in a major administrative reshuffle aimed at improving transparency, accountability and financial management across departments.
- The Delhi Electricity Regulatory Commission has revised regulations to speed up EV charging infrastructure rollout under the PM E-Drive scheme, removing key financial hurdles and encouraging greater private investment in public charging stations.

Goa

- The 5.15-km six-lane Porvorim Flyover has reached a key construction milestone with the installation of its final span, bringing the project closer to completion and improving connectivity while easing traffic congestion on NH-66.

Gujarat

- Heavy monsoon rains lashed Gujarat, prompting the India Meteorological Department to issue red alerts for seven districts as flooding damaged roads, disrupted normal life and triggered rescue operations in affected areas.
- Gujarat Police has launched the 28-day 'Operation Surakshit Cyberspace' campaign to enhance online safety for women and children through cyber awareness, victim outreach and technology-driven policing, targeting over 45 lakh citizens and students across the state.

Haryana

- Haryana State Pollution Control Board has begun drone surveys of 11 drains flowing into the Yamuna River to identify pollution sources, monitor water quality in real time and crack down on illegal sewage and industrial discharges.
- Municipal Corporation of Gurugram has proposed a ₹450-crore, five-year mechanised city cleaning plan featuring 72 road-sweeping machines and 2,500 sanitation workers to improve cleanliness and reduce dust pollution across Gurugram.

Himachal Pradesh

- Himachal Pradesh has inaugurated its first fully wireless CCTV Command and Control Centre in Haroli, with 195 cameras installed at 60 locations to strengthen surveillance, traffic management and crime detection.
- Himachal Pradesh has notified the VB-G RAM G rural employment scheme with ₹1,435 crore in Central and state funding, providing at least 125 days of guaranteed wage employment and priority support for vulnerable households.

Karnataka

- Karnataka has issued new digital crop survey guidelines allowing farmers to self-report crop details through a mobile app, with GPS and satellite verification to support crop insurance, disaster relief and other government schemes.
- Asian Development Bank has approved a ₹2,000-crore loan to strengthen Karnataka's public school system, supporting 500 integrated school clusters and benefiting over one million students through infrastructure, teacher training and curriculum reforms.

Upcoming News/Events

Andhra Pradesh

- Andhra Pradesh will adopt Tamil Nadu's medicine procurement model by forming an expert panel to streamline drug purchases and ensure uninterrupted supplies at government hospitals, while also reviewing broader healthcare infrastructure expansion.
- Andhra Pradesh plans to pilot the digital rupee for ration distribution in Vijayawada and Visakhapatnam later this year, aiming to improve transparency, accountability and beneficiary flexibility in the Public Distribution System.

Delhi

- The Government of Delhi will launch the ₹8,300-crore "Clean Air, Healthy Delhi" programme with support from the World Bank, targeting pollution from transport, construction, road dust, waste management and industries over the next seven years.
- The Govt. plans to procure 2,800 more electric buses under the PM E-Drive scheme, pending cabinet approval. The new buses are expected to begin arriving by early 2027, taking Delhi's electric bus fleet to around 8,000.
- The Delhi Traffic Police has urged the Municipal Corporation of Delhi to relocate seven toll plazas in east Delhi to ease congestion, citing daily traffic bottlenecks and road safety concerns on key routes connecting Delhi and Uttar Pradesh.

Goa

- CM Pramod Sawant proposed appointing two brand ambassadors to strengthen the Green Goa Clean Goa campaign, while encouraging women and self-help groups to lead community-driven cleanliness efforts with government support.

Gujarat

- The Gujarat Police Recruitment Board has scheduled the written examination for 950 Class-3 Technical Cadre posts in the Wireless and Motor Transport departments on August 23, with candidates advised to check the official website for admit card and exam updates.
- IIT Gandhinagar will establish the ₹190-crore SAMARTH semiconductor research and training hub to strengthen India's chip ecosystem, with a target of training over 10,000 students and professionals in advanced semiconductor technologies over the next five years.

Haryana

- Agriculture Minister Shyam Singh Rana will launch the 'Naveen Krishi Sankalp Abhiyan' from Yamunanagar on July 7, connecting farmers with agricultural experts and promoting modern farming, crop diversification and government schemes.
- Construction of Shri Krishna AYUSH University's permanent campus in Kurukshetra will begin soon after the Haryana government awarded the ₹465-crore first-phase contract, with the project set to strengthen AYUSH education, research and healthcare infrastructure.

Himachal Pradesh

- Himachal Pradesh will develop faecal sludge co-treatment systems at 30 sewerage treatment plants by March 2027, improving rural sanitation and safe waste disposal across nearly 7,000 villages.
- Himachal Pradesh will raise an additional ₹700 crore loan, taking its total borrowings in 2026-27 to ₹2,800 crore, as the cash-strapped state seeks funds for development amid mounting fiscal pressure.

Karnataka

- Chief Minister D. K. Shivakumar met former CM Siddaramaiah as Karnataka's cabinet expansion is expected between July 10 and 14, with the final decision likely after consultations with Rahul Gandhi.
- CM D. K. Shivakumar has sought a comprehensive review of Karnataka's mining policy, directing officials to frame rules for timely commencement of mining after auctions and crack down on inactive lease holders.

INDIA UPDATE

Highlights of this week

Madhya Pradesh

- Madhya Pradesh and Maharashtra held a joint coordination meeting to strengthen security along their border, exchanging lists of accused persons and coordinating measures to curb interstate crime.

Mumbai

- Brihanmumbai Municipal Corporation awarded ₹42.24 crore in tree maintenance contracts to private firms across Mumbai, with the move drawing scrutiny after recent fatal tree collapses raised concerns over contractor expertise and work quality.
- Brihanmumbai Electric Supply and Transport has identified nearly 1,200 underground cable fault locations in Mumbai but is awaiting permission from the Brihanmumbai Municipal Corporation to dig concrete roads and carry out long-pending repairs.
- The Government of Maharashtra has introduced the Maharashtra Clinical Establishments Bill to replace a 1949 law, mandating registration of all healthcare facilities and strengthening regulation, transparency and patient rights across the state.

Pune

- CM Devendra Fadnavis said the Pavana pipeline project for Pimpri-Chinchwad's water supply will proceed only after farmers' consent, while directing officials to prepare a long-term regional water security plan up to 2050.
- Maha Metro has finalised the Kalyaninagar–Pune Airport Metro alignment and will prepare its DPR, while also expanding the proposed Karve Road double-decker flyover up to Vandevi to improve Metro connectivity and ease traffic congestion.
- Pune Municipal Corporation has approved widening the Yerawada–Sangamwadi road to 30 metres to ease congestion, while also launching a citywide drive to remove footpath encroachments ahead of the Palkhi and Ganesh festivals.

Punjab

- Punjab has earmarked ₹600 crore for flood preparedness ahead of the monsoon, with funds being used to strengthen embankments, repair breaches, desilt rivers and upgrade flood protection infrastructure across the state.
- Government of Punjab has simplified norms for regularising eligible unauthorised colonies, allowing applications until September 30 and easing property regularisation for thousands of residents across the state.

Rajasthan

- Rajasthan demonstrated the growing role of space-based surveillance in border security during Operation Sindoor, with satellite systems helping detect and thwart drone threats as India expands its defence network with 52 new surveillance satellites.

Tamil Nadu

- Confederation of Indian Industry has proposed strategies to strengthen air connectivity to Chennai, including advancing the Parandur airport project and regional partnerships to support industrial growth across southern India.
- Tamil Nadu held a regional consultation with farmers from 10 districts to shape the 2026-27 agriculture budget, focusing on irrigation, farm income, mechanisation, natural farming and crop insurance.

Telangana

- Telangana has approved joining the VB-G RAM G rural employment scheme from July 1 while deciding to challenge the Act in the Supreme Court of India, and also extended the midday meal scheme to teachers and non-teaching staff.
- Telangana has introduced weighbridge-based checks and a verified driver registry for mining trucks to curb overloading, improve road safety and strengthen enforcement through digital integration with transport databases.

Uttar Pradesh

- Uttar Pradesh reaffirmed its target of achieving 22 GW of renewable energy capacity as policymakers and industry experts discussed strategies to accelerate clean energy adoption, rural development and solar investment.
- Uttar Pradesh said infrastructure development across transport, industry, power and digital services will be key to achieving its \$1 trillion economy target, with a focus on connectivity, investment and job creation.

Upcoming News/Events

Madhya Pradesh

- Madhya Pradesh will set up a defence manufacturing plant in Shivpuri, where Chief Minister Mohan Yadav and Jyotiraditya Scindia will also launch and lay foundation stones for development projects worth ₹211.29 crore.

Mumbai

- The Government of Maharashtra said Mumbai will get three stray dog shelters within six months, while feeding of stray dogs will be restricted to designated zones in line with Supreme Court of India directions.
- The Maharashtra Legislative Assembly has passed a bill to speed up recovery in financial fraud cases by expediting disposal of attached properties, while bringing cryptocurrency and blockchain-based scams under the MPID Act.
- The Government of Maharashtra has proposed a two-step recycling process for Plaster-of-Paris Ganesh idols, involving immersion in artificial tanks followed by processing, to enable scientific reuse ahead of the Ganpati festival.

Pune

- Pune Municipal Corporation has urged devotees to avoid DJs and loudspeakers during the palkhi procession to preserve its spiritual atmosphere, while making extensive sanitation, shelter and healthcare arrangements for pilgrims.
- CM Devendra Fadnavis will set up an expert panel to examine restoring the original Pune–Nashik semi-high-speed rail route via Sangamner and Narayangaon after objections to the revised alignment via Ahilyanagar and Shirdi.
- Indian Railways will invest ₹1,600 crore to upgrade five stations in Nashik ahead of the Simhastha Kumbh Mela, enhancing passenger facilities and rail operations to handle the expected surge in pilgrims.

Punjab

- Punjab has directed unaided private schools to complete admissions under the 25% RTE quota by July 20, barring screening tests or fees for selected EWS and disadvantaged students.
- The Punjab Roadways (PUNBUS) will decide employees' regularisation claims within four weeks, after the Punjab and Haryana High Court clarified that it had ordered consideration of the claims, not automatic regularisation.

Rajasthan

- Rajasthan will get a new PM Shri Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalaya in Phalasia, Udaipur, after the Centre approved the project and asked the district administration to begin land allotment for the school.

Tamil Nadu

- Tamil Nadu is planning a multi-phase World Tamil Conference across countries including the US and UK, with global consultations underway to promote Tamil language, culture and international academic collaboration.
- Deep-sea fishermen in Tamil Nadu have urged the Centre to allow two-way satellite internet on fishing vessels, saying it would improve safety, real-time weather access and direct market links for better returns on their catch.

Telangana

- Telangana is planning an AI-powered integrated traffic signal system for Hyderabad to ease congestion, improve emergency response and manage traffic more efficiently during heavy rains using real-time intelligence.
- Telangana will develop an 86-acre Japan-inspired Eco Town in Siddapur based on the Kitakyushu model, promoting circular economy practices, waste recycling and sustainable urban development near Hyderabad.

Uttar Pradesh

- Meerut's Kailash Prakash Stadium remains incomplete ahead of the Indian Athletics Series on August 29, with key athlete facilities unfinished despite a target to complete the work by August 15.
- Uttar Pradesh will redesign teaching and assessment for over one crore UP Board students by developing a new State Curriculum Framework aligned with the National Curriculum Framework 2023 from the 2026–27 academic year.



GLOBAL UPDATE

Highlights of this week

Upcoming News/Events

Africa - South Africa has deployed more than 3,000 soldiers nationwide to support police during weekly anti-migrant protests, as authorities step up security measures to maintain law and order amid planned demonstrations. - United States has withdrawn most of its forces from Nigeria after a joint operation against ISIS militants, while continuing intelligence-sharing support at Abuja's request to aid ongoing counterterrorism efforts.
America - Peru has declared a 60-day state of emergency in 796 districts, covering about 40% of the country, to prepare for heavy rainfall linked to the El Niño weather phenomenon. Regional and local authorities will coordinate emergency measures to reduce risks using existing government resources. - Canada and Mexico face uncertainty after the U.S.-Mexico-Canada Agreement (USMCA) entered a review period, with the pact now on track to expire in a decade unless all three countries agree on changes.
Asia Pacific - North Korea conducted strategic cruise missile and naval weapons tests aboard its new destroyer Kang Kon under the supervision of Kim Jong Un, who ordered the warship to be commissioned within two months as part of the country's naval modernisation drive. - India and Japan signed agreements to deepen cooperation in AI, critical minerals, energy, defence and economic security after talks between Narendra Modi and Sanae Takaichi, while also agreeing to prepare a joint economic security roadmap.
China - China has launched a new coast guard patrol east of Taiwan despite international concerns, prompting a sharp response from Taipei after a similar operation last month drew criticism from several Western capitals. - China's Xi Jinping promoted two military officers to the rank of general and appointed Zhang Shuguang as the armed forces' new anti-corruption chief, as Beijing continues its military anti-graft campaign and leadership reshuffle.
Europe Germany said there are still unresolved issues before the European Union–Mercosur Free Trade Agreement can be ratified, though Foreign Minister Johann Wadephul expressed confidence that the remaining differences can be resolved.
Middle East - Egypt expects to receive a €1.5 billion tranche from the European Union in the coming days under its €5 billion macro-financial assistance package. Cairo expects the remaining €1.5 billion to be disbursed by the start of autumn. - Turkey and Iraq held talks on expanding energy cooperation, including the Iraq–Turkey Crude Oil Pipeline, as both countries prepare for the expiry of the pipeline agreement and explore future collaboration.
Pakistan Pakistan said it shot down four drones in Balochistan after Afghanistan claimed to have carried out airstrikes inside Pakistani territory, marking a fresh escalation in cross-border tensions between the two neighbours.
United Kingdom Andy Burnham, the frontrunner to become the United Kingdom's next prime minister, said he has not yet decided on a finance minister for a future government while defending his record on managing public finances.
United States - The United States has declined to extend the U.S.-Mexico-Canada Agreement (USMCA), starting the process to wind down the deal while seeking changes to boost domestic manufacturing and reduce trade deficits with Canada and Mexico. - Donald Trump marked the United States's 250th anniversary with a campaign-style rally on Washington's National Mall, concluding weeks of celebrations amid tight security, extreme heat and heightened political divisions.

Africa - United States will invest more than \$1.3 billion in Tanzania's health sector over five years under a new agreement, while Tanzania has committed to invest \$1.8 billion to strengthen self-sustaining healthcare services. - United Nations warned that the Ebola outbreak could cost Africa up to \$3.6 billion and result in 328,000 job losses if it spreads beyond affected countries, urging swift containment measures to prevent a wider health and economic crisis across the region.
America - Canada aims to announce around 10 founding countries for a global defence bank at next week's NATO summit in Ankara. The proposed bank is expected to raise up to £100 billion in low-cost financing to strengthen defence capabilities. - Mercosur has launched negotiations with Japan for an economic partnership agreement as the South American bloc seeks to expand global trade ties following its EU deal. Mercosur also signalled interest in strengthening economic cooperation with China amid shifting global trade dynamics.
Asia Pacific - India's Prime Minister Narendra Modi will visit Indonesia, Australia and New Zealand next week to strengthen strategic, economic and regional cooperation as India expands its engagement in the Asia-Pacific region. - South Korea President Lee Jae Myung will attend the NATO summit in Ankara on July 7–8 to strengthen defence cooperation with member states, before visiting Mongolia as part of his regional diplomatic tour.
China China has proposed easing refinancing rules for listed companies to help eligible firms raise capital faster through simplified private share placements, while also strengthening oversight of convertible bond issuances.
Europe - NATO leaders, including Donald Trump, are expected to reaffirm their "ironclad" commitment to Article 5 collective defence at the Ankara summit, while pledging €70 billion in military aid for Ukraine in 2026 and continued support in 2027. - Germany's draft 2027 budget proposes borrowing more than €203 billion to boost investment and defence spending, as Berlin seeks to revive its economy and address the impact of war-related energy shocks and years of underinvestment.
Middle East - Iran has begun talks to resume oil exports to Japan under a temporary U.S. sanctions waiver, though potential buyers are seeking a longer exemption and assurances over shipping safety before making purchases. - Turkey has expressed interest in joining the Single Euro Payments Area payment system, with Turkish and European Union institutions continuing talks to enable faster, cheaper and more secure cross-border euro payments.
Pakistan Amid escalating border tensions with Afghanistan, Pakistan received a call from Russia to resolve its disputes with Kabul through political dialogue and diplomacy following the recent cross-border clashes and airstrikes.
United Kingdom - United Kingdom hopes to hold a new summit with the European Union after the summer to advance efforts to reset post-Brexit relations, with British officials stressing that closer cooperation is crucial amid rising global uncertainty. - United Kingdom will remove the mandatory pre-application consultation requirement for major infrastructure projects later this month, saying the planning reform could cut approval timelines by up to 12 months and accelerate project delivery.
United States The United States administration plans to roll back commercial fishing regulations nationwide, including reopening parts of New England to scallop fishing, aiming to boost the industry while easing restrictions.

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
